

- 3. The candidate's height will be measured as follows:—He will be placed against the standard with his feet together, and the weight thrown on the heels and not on the toes or outer sides of the feet. He will stand erect without rigidity, and with the heels, calves, buttocks and shoulders touching the standard; the chin will be depressed to bring the vertex of the head level under the horizontal bar, and the height will be recorded in inches and parts of an inch to quarters.
- 4. The candidate's chest will be measured as follows:—He will be made to stand erect with his feet together, and to raise his arms over his head. The tape will be so adjusted round the chest that its upper edge touches the inferior angles of the shoulder blades behind, and its lower edge the upper part of the nipples in front. The arms will then be lowered to hang loosely by the side, and care will be taken that the shoulders are not thrown upwards or backwards so as to displace the tape. The candidate will then be directed to take a deep inspiration several times, and the maximum expansion of the chest will be carefully noted.

The minimum and maximum will then be recorded thus in inches $\frac{33}{35}$, $\frac{34}{36\frac{1}{2}}$ &c.

In recording the measurements, fractions of less than half-an-inch should not be noted.

- 5. The candidate will also be weighed, and his weight recorded in pounds. Fractions of a pound should not be noted.
- 6. The examination for determining the acuteness of vision includes two tests: one for distant, the other for near vision. The Army Test Types will be used for the test for distant vision, without glasses at a distance of 20 feet, and for the test for near vision without glasses, at any distance selected by the candidate. The standards of the minimum acuteness of vision with which a candidate will be considered fit are as follows:—

PHYSICAL CONDITIONS.

- 1. To be passed as fit for appointment to a commission in the Territorial Army a candidate must be in good mental and bodily health, and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of military duty. For candidates seeking commissions in Air Defence of Great Britain and Coast Defence Units modifications in the physical standards are authorised as detailed in paragraph 9.
 - 2. The correlation of age, height, and chest-girth will not be less than that given in the following table:—

- 3. The candidate's height will be measured as follows:—He will be placed against the standard with his feet together, and the weight thrown on the heels and not on the toes or outer sides of the feet. He will stand erect without rigidity, and with the heels, calves, buttocks and shoulders touching the standard; the chin will be depressed to bring the vertex of the head level under the horizontal bar, and the height will be recorded in inches and parts of an inch to quarters.
- 4. The candidate's chest will be measured as follows:—He will be made to stand erect with his feet together, and to raise his arms over his head. The tape will be so adjusted round the chest that its upper edge touches the inferior angles of the shoulder blades behind, and its lower edge the upper part of the nipples in front. The arms will then be lowered to hang loosely by the side, and care will be taken that the shoulders are not thrown upwards or backwards so as to displace the tape. The candidate will then be directed to take a deep inspiration several times, and the maximum expansion of the chest will be carefully noted.

The minimum and maximum will then be recorded thus in inches $\frac{33}{36}$ &c. $\frac{34}{35}$ &c.

In recording the measurements, fractions of less than half-an-inch should not be noted.

- 5. The candidate will also be weighed, and his weight recorded in pounds. Fractions of a pound should not be noted.
- 6. The examination for determining the acuteness of vision includes two tests: one for distant, the other for near vision. The Army Test Types will be used for the test for distant vision, without glasses at a distance of 20 feet under standard illumination, and for the test for near vision without glasses, at any distance selected by the candidate. The standard of the minimum acuteness of vision with which a candidate will be considered fit is as follows:—

Distant Vision.—V, without glasses = not below 6/60, and after correction with glasses = not below 6/6.

Worse Eye.

V, without glasses=not below 6/60; and after correction with glasses = not below 6/12.

Each eye will be examined separately and the lids must be kept wide open during the lest.

Squint or any morbid condition of the eyes or of the lids of either eye liable to the risk of aggravation or recurrence, may cause the rejection of the candidate.

Inability to distinguish the principal colours will not be regarded as a cause for rejection, but the fact will be noted in the proceedings and the candidate will be informed.

7. The following additional points will then be observed:—

- (a) That his hearing is good and there is no sign of ear disease.
- (b) That his speech is without impediment.
- (c) That his teeth are in good order. He must have 10 sound teeth in the upper jaw functionally opposed to 10 sound teeth in the lower jaw. Two of these teeth in each jaw must be molars. Well-filled teeth will be considered as sound.
- (d) That his chest is well formed and that his lungs and heart are sound.
- (e) That he is not ruptured.

- (f) That undescended testicle is only considered a bar when situated within the inguinal canal or at the external ring. Successful removal of an undescended testicle is not a disqualification.
- (g) That he does not suffer from a severe degree of varicose veins. A candidate who has been successfully operated on will be accepted.
- (h) That his limbs are well formed and developed.
- (i) That there is free and perfect motion of all the joints.
- (j) That his feet and toes are well formed.
- (k) That he does not suffer from any inveterate skin disease.
- (1) That he has no congenital malformation or defect.
- (m) That he does not bear traces of previous acute or chronic disease pointing to an impaired constitution.
- 8. If the candidate, in the opinion of the Medical Officer, does not appear to be of pure European descent a statement to this effect will be entered in the report.
- 9. The modifications in physical standards authorised for Air Defence of Great Britain and Coast Defence Units are:—
 - (1) Dental. The existing standard is abolished and a candidate may be accepted if he possesses well fitting dentures irrespective of the number of natural teeth absent.
 - (2) Chest Measurement. A candidate may be accepted if he is not more than 2-in. below the existing standard.
 - (3) Vision. A candidate may be accepted whose distant vision without glasses is below 6/60 provided correction with glasses brings his distant vision up to the corrected vision of the standard.
 - (4) Limbs and Joints. A candidate with a degree of flat foot, hammer toe or knock knee may be accepted.
 - (5) Speech. A candidate with slight hesitation in speech may be accepted



CONDITIONS OF SERVICE.

On undertaking the liability to serve abroad in time of national emergency, an officer or man of the Territorial Force will be required to sign an agreement, on Army Form E. 624, in the presence of the Officer Commanding the Territorial unit to which he belongs, and, unless notification to the contrary is given to the Commanding Officer, the liability will continue as long as the officer's or man's engagement in the Territorial Force lasts.
- 2. The engagement on Army Form E. 624, of an officer or man of the Territorial Force to accept liability for service outside the United Kingdom in time of national emergency, will be to serve with his own unit, or with a part of his own unit, only. He cannot, under this agreement, be drafted as an individual to any other unit.
- 3. Except as regards liability for foreign service, the conditions of the officer's or man's service in the Territorial Force will not be affected by this agreement.
- 4. A badge will be awarded to each individual accepting such liability for service outside the United Kingdom. This badge will be worn, when in uniform, on the right breast of the officer or man so long as the liability continues.
