

Bill Gardner's Notebook:

The few pages in this document are copied from an accounts ledger used by Bill Gardner as a record of issues of stores to sub-units and men under his command during WW2. The ledger was used, as late as 1980, by Bill for actual finance information hence some of the scribbled entries on the pages.

Lieutenant (later Major) W G Gardner was a Group Commander in 12 Corps Observation Unit which, from August 1943, was renamed Auxiliary Units, Kent Area, Home Forces. Bill Gardner served as Group Commander with the Kent Area Auxiliary Units until 'stand down' at the end of 1944.
