11. (a) If qualifying service was with the Army, this form will be forwarded to the War Office for officers, and to the appropriate Record Office for other ranks.
- (b) If former R.N., R.M., R.A.F. or Home Guard service is to be added to an incomplete period of Army service, this form should be sent to the appropriate authority for the completion of Part III, and onward transmission to the War Office or Record Office concerned.
